課程名稱	課程內容
國文 (旅外歸國)	提供旅外歸國的學生適性學習、適性評量、加強國文基本能力之課 程。(申請者需經過中學雙語部辦公室審核通過方能參加)
美術培訓課程	協助學生培養美術創作技巧、參加美展比賽、累計個人美術作品 集。
G7-9 Writing Foundations Builder 加強 Reading, Grammar, and Vocabulary 適合英文需要額外協助者	This course provides a structured introduction to the fundamentals of grammar, sentence construction, and paragraph development. Students will build the essential skills needed to craft clear and effective writing, while steadily improving their grammar and expanding their academic vocabulary. With a strong emphasis on foundational language skills, this course is especially well-suited for English Language Learners seeking to strengthen their command of English for academic success. Students can expect: - to be introduced to effective sentences and word choice - construct a variety of sentences - structure their thoughts in a cohesive and coherent manner - learn and develop skills in unique writing elements - homework: writing paragraphs / essays / individual sentences relating to skills developed in the classroom.
G7-9 Academic Writing Class 加強 Academic Writing 適合英文能力中上者	 This course offers students with strong foundations in English grammar and vocabulary an opportunity to hone their academic writing skills. Students will learn about the various types of academic writing, such as expository, persuasive, cause & effect essays, and how to approach these prompts effectively. Students will work closely with the teacher to identify weaknesses in their writing and refi ne their writing to obtain a high standard of academic writing. Students can expect: 15 minutes of preparatory writing exercises across academic essay topics. 45 minutes for introducing an essay style and analyzing model essays. 30 minutes of writing practice to allow students to practice and grow their writing skills alongside the guidance of the teacher. homework: writing paragraphs / essays / individual sentences relating to skills developed in the classroom.
G10 Academic Writing Class 加強 Reading, Grammar, and Vocabulary Duolingo English Test 成績未達 100 分者應參加	 This course guides students through the essential processes of academic writing. Students will learn to generate and organize ideas in response to prompts, connect their thoughts logically, identify and correct reasoning errors, paraphrase effectively, and construct well-supported arguments. Emphasizing critical thinking and clarity, the course helps students build confidence and precision in their academic writing. Students can expect: 15 minutes of editing for common grammatical errors in upper school academic essays. 30 minutes of editing and revisions. 30 minutes for building writing skills in writing effective introductions, body paragraphs, and conclusions. homework: writing paragraphs and answering essay prompts.
G9-10 SAT and AP Social Studies Reading and Critical Thinking Skills	comprehension skills on reading passages for the SAT as well as for AP courses like World History, US History, Government, and Geography. Students will take sample tests and discuss answers as well as analyze primary and secondary sources for writing short answer responses and argument essays.

G10-11 US Government and Politics	This course will teach the skills and content covered in AP US Government and Politics. Students will learn about constitutionalism, liberty and order, civic participation, competing policymaking interests, and methods of political analysis. Students who want to take the AP US Government and Politics test in May are encouraged to take this class. This class is non-credit and will not be recorded on official transcripts.	
G7-9 Basic German	 This course introduces junior high students to the basics of the German language. The class focuses on developing foundational skills in listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Students will learn essential vocabulary and phrases related to everyday topics such as greetings, numbers, colors, family, school, and hobbies. Basic grammar concepts like sentence structure, verb conjugation, and noun gender will be introduced. No prior German experience is necessary. This course is perfect for beginners who are curious about learning a new language.
