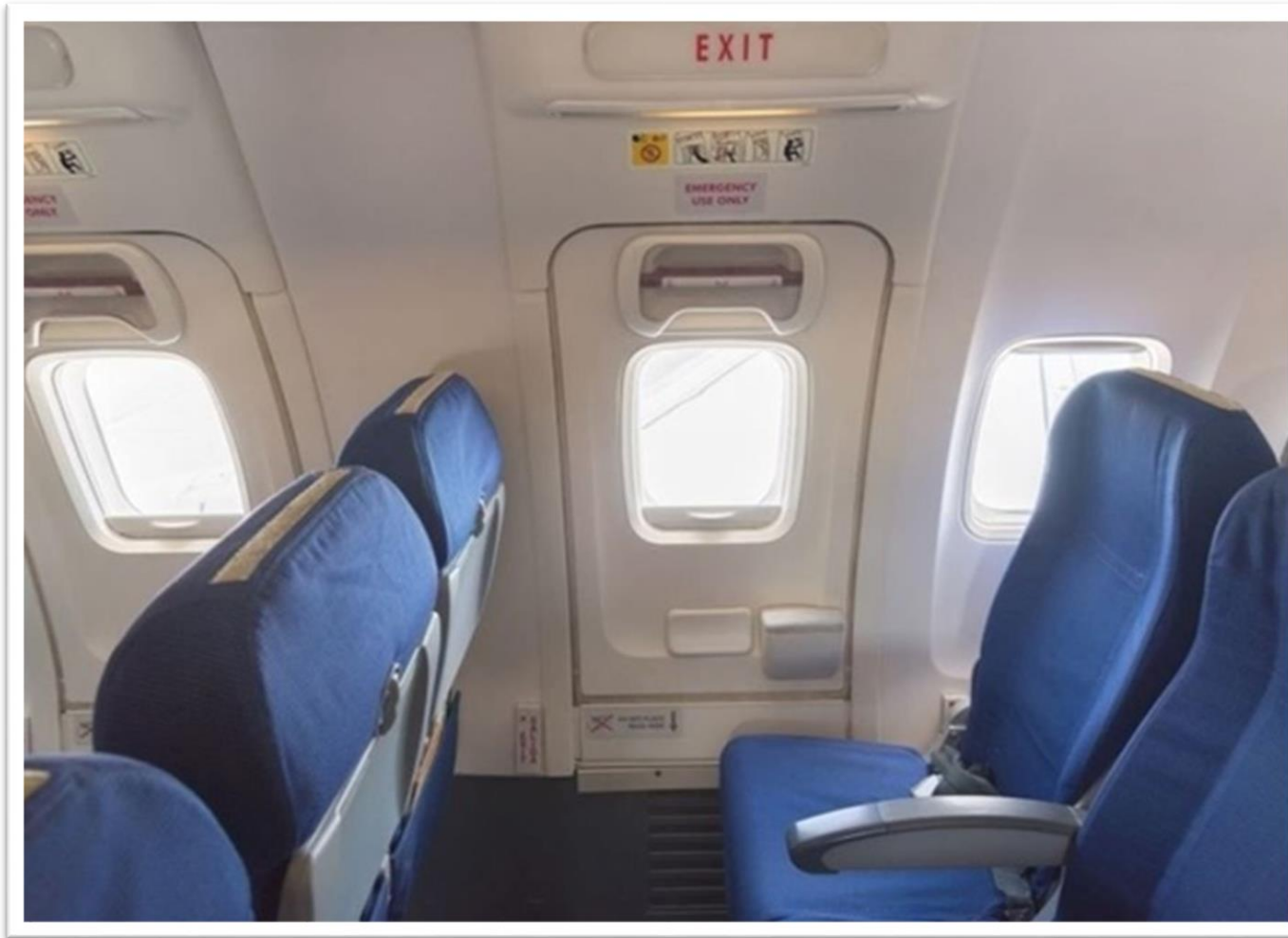

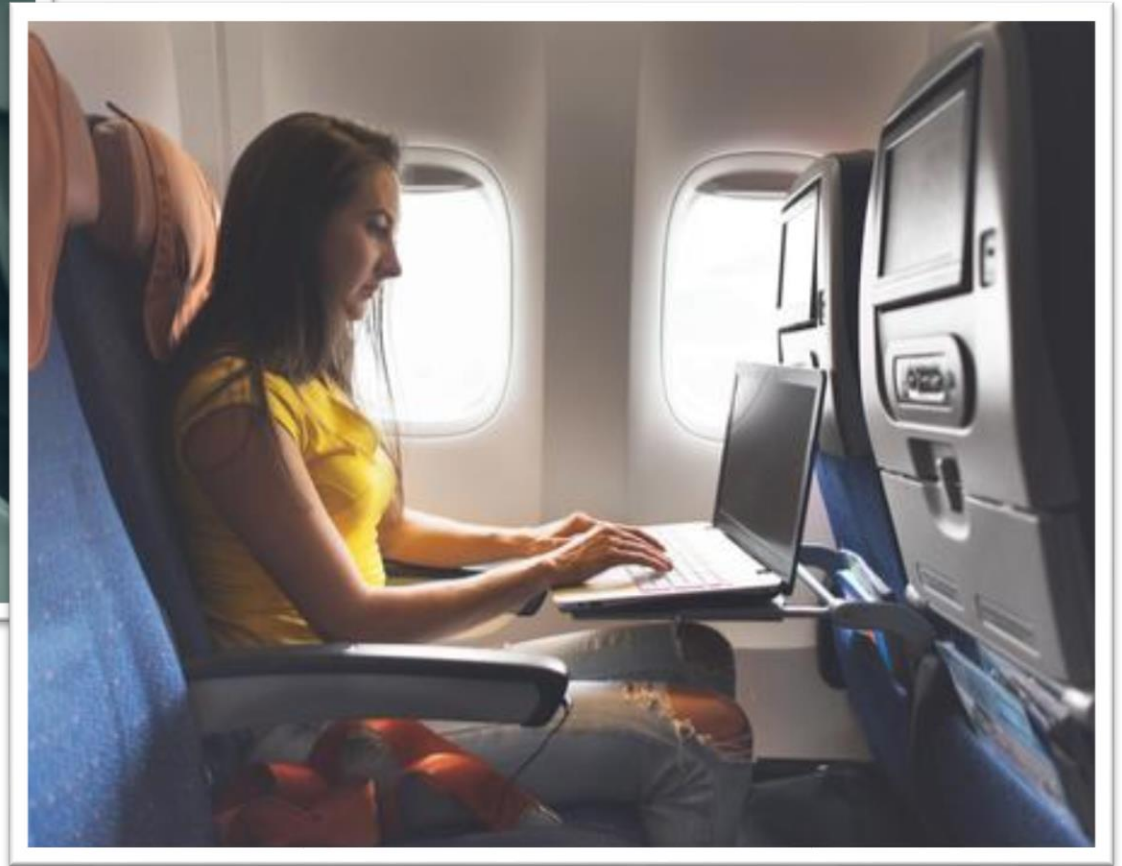

Flight Safety Rules



1. We must switch off or turn off all electronic devices.



2. We mustn't smoke on the plane.



3. In case of emergency, you need to know where the emergency exits are.



Emergency Exits DO NOT OPEN EXIT for fire, debris or obstruction.

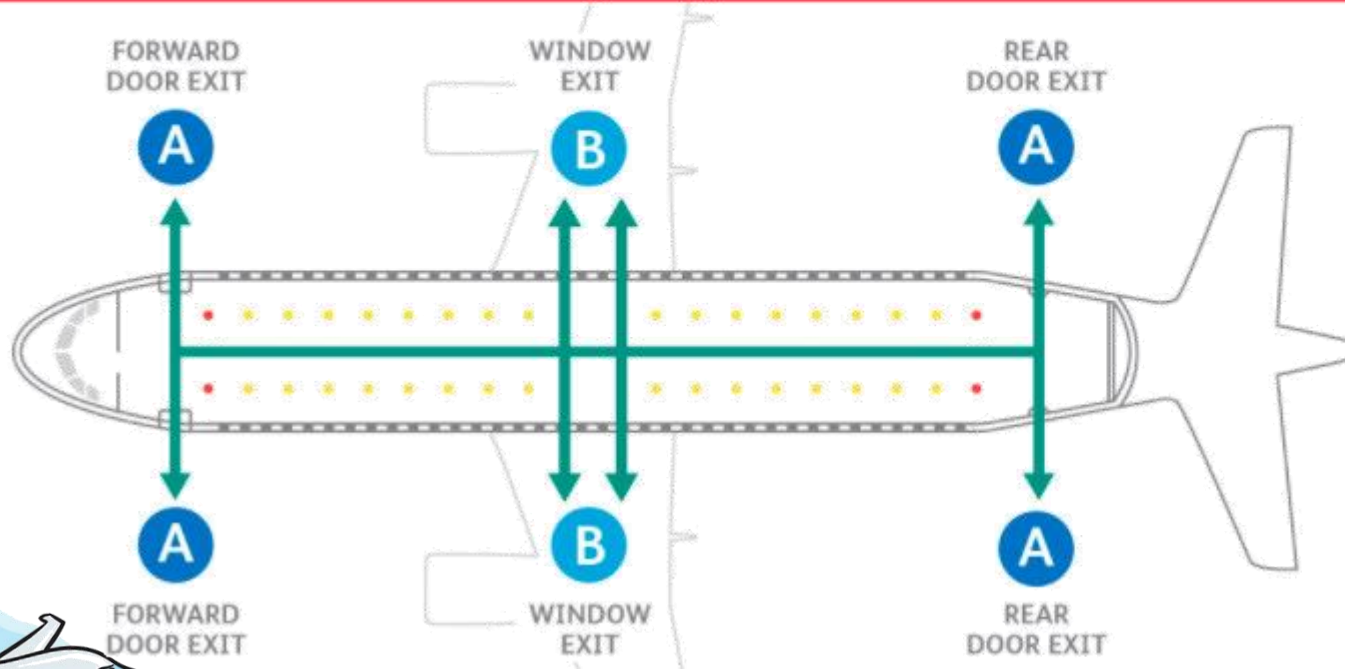


Fire / Smoke:

Use clothing to cover nose and mouth,
Stay low.



Follow the escape path
lights leading to exits.



4. Store your baggage away in the overhead compartments or under the seat in front of you !

Landing



Stow bags in overhead bin or push bag under the seat. Stow tables. Straighten seat back. Open windows.

5. Fasten your seat belt when taking off or landing.

Fasten seatbelt



Pull on strap to tighten

6. Review and practice the brace position before takeoff.



There are different versions of the brace position: In some you hold your ankles, in others you cross your arms over the seat in front of you. (CBC) Find a way you feel comfortable or secure.



“Brace For Impact”

In case of emergency landing, follow one of the positions below.

Normal Bracing Position

Adult with infant

Pregnant



7. In case of emergency, we pull down on the oxygen mask and place it over their nose and mouth. Please make sure we've got our mask on before we help others.



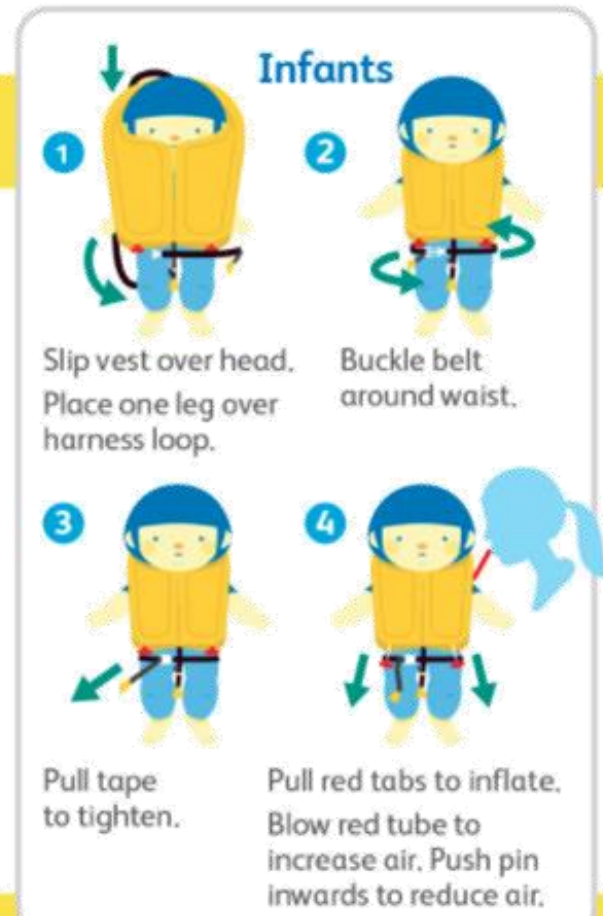
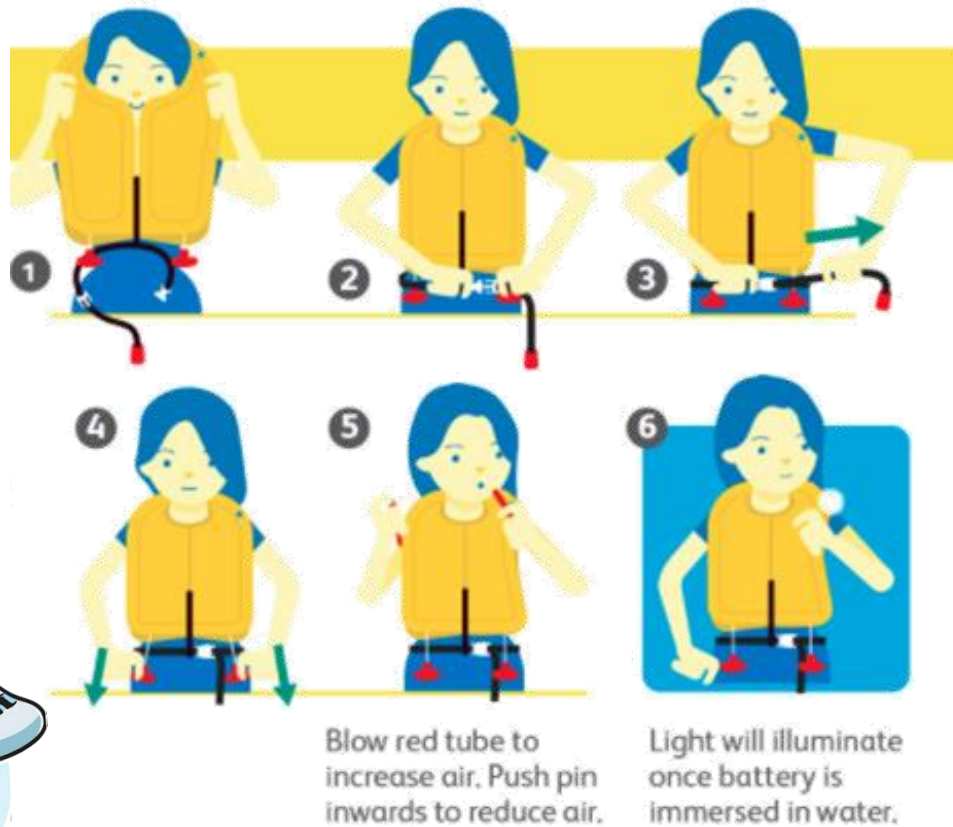
Oxygen Masks

In case of decompression, oxygen masks will drop automatically from overhead compartments.



If you are traveling with a child, first put your own mask and then the child's mask.

8. We put on life jackets when the airplane has made an emergency water landing. They can be found underneath the seat or armrests, etc. Put it over your head to wear. Vests for infants are also available.
